



Alpine Air is a new company offering friendly professional hospitality in a beautiful timber Savoyard chalet in the farming hamlet of Suvay, just outside the village of Châtel, offering views of the valley and Mont De Grange.

Chalet Papillon is a brand new 5 en-suite bedroom luxury chalet that is run on a catered basis. The chalet is ideal for families, groups or corporate bookings.

The lounge is an open plan area with a large fireplace encompassing a living area with satellite television offering most sky channels. The lounge is 15.04m long x 4.02 wide. All this area has a 1.2m wide balcony and a 3m terrace offering views of the valley and Mont De Grange. The dining area is 8.3m x 3.3m connected to the kitchen. There is also a toilet and basin located near the front door. Outside there is a hot tub to soothe away the aches and pains of a hard day on the piste.

Sunday change over days, offering free transfers to and from Geneva Airport. Easy access from Geneva ensures you will get maximum time on the slopes, whether it's for a week or a weekend.

It all starts with a fantastic welcome spread of either afternoon tea (made up of a delicious freshly baked cake, fresh bread, jam, tea and coffee) or a snuffle of champagne with some tasty appetisers to get the mouth watering in preparation for dinner.



A welcome and introduction by the host will be followed by dinner.

Each morning (6 days out of 7) the host will prepare a hearty breakfast whilst guests prepare themselves for the slopes.

A selection of cereals, yoghurts, fresh fruit, jams and other spreads, milk, juices, fresh pastries ham and cheese bread, tea, coffee and hot chocolate. A cooked option or porridge is always available for those who need that bit extra.

Dinner

Pre dinner drinks, beer, gin and tonics etc are included. If you have a favourite tippie you are welcome to bring your own Duty Free.

For 6 nights the host will prepare a delicious three-course meal with quality French wine, coffee and mints, cheese board available.

Dietary needs can be catered for (let us have this information at your time of booking). If you feel there is something you are unable to do without, you are welcome to bring it with you.

As a courtesy to other guests this is a no smoking chalet.



Around Châtel

Châtel has an impressive local domain. It is also part of the massive Portes du Soleil ski domain - the largest international linked ski area in the world with over 650 km of pistes in both France and Switzerland, and a superb snow record.

The Portes du Soleil is so large that it is one of the few ski areas that can say truthfully 'there is something for everyone'. It is well known as being an intermediates paradise - mile after mile of piste allows you to cover a huge amount of ground. The terrain is so varied and there is so much to discover that it keeps people coming back year after year.

Good news, a new lift from Les Lindarets is under construction and should be operational for 2007 season

This replaces the slow three man lift Chaux Fleurie, speeding up the return to Châtel.

For experts, the amount of easily accessible off piste is just phenomenal. You can easily spend whole days skiing without touching the pistes once, and without any hiking. There are also a number of good, steep black runs including the infamous 'Swiss Wall' which is reputed to be the steepest run in the Alps.



The Snow Record

Châtel and the Portes Du Soleil both have an enviable snow record. Their proximity to Mont Blanc and Lac Lemman creates a micro-climate which means that the area tends to get significant snowfall from the start of December through to when the lifts close in late April.

Because most of the lower slopes are pasture land, depths of 10-20cms are often all that is required to open the pistes, compared with higher altitude resorts where a metre or so is needed to cover the rocks.
